General Reminders

Tuition is due the first school day of the month. Cash is readily accepted. Please put cash in an envelope with your **child's** name on the outside and we will gladly issue you a receipt. If you are paying by check, it is not necessary to put in an envelope but please put your child's name on the bottom left corner of the check. Any notes from home, homework, letter pocket pictures, and tuition payments can be put right in the lunchbox. We check every lunchbox at the start of each school day.

*It is very important that you put your child's name in all their outerwear that your child wears to school. Thank you.

Drop Off and Pick Up reminders- Parents please be courteous when lining up your cars on the street. Do not block anyone's driveway including the school driveway. When you are the first car, pull all the way up to the telephone pole in front of the school so 2 cars can fit right in front of the school so you do not block our driveway. Be extra careful coming up Yale Ave. before making a right to pull onto Waterman Ave. as there are cars lined up Waterman to your left.

In the months of October and March we now collect an **Enrichment Fee**. As explained in the parent handbook it is necessary to raise funds outside of the monthly tuition payment in order to maintain a high quality program. Our **Enrichment Fee** takes the place of fund raisers that most other schools request your participation. Attached is the envelope that we would like you to submit your fee in by the end of October. Please refrain from combining this fee and tuition in one check. I would like to keep them separate. This small fee helps to cover the costs of the many extras here at Cherry Hill. We thank you all for your support. It is greatly appreciated.

School News

For the month of October we will be discussing the season of Fall, fire safety, owls and Halloween. We have many stories, activities and crafts planned. Our classroom will make its monthly transformation changing out activities, games, centers and decorations to go along with our theme. We will be focusing on listening skills with all students, as well as self-help skills and fine motor development. This month you will all be receiving a take-home project with instructions on how to complete it. This is a great way to spend some time with your child and encourage some creativity and discussion. For our pre-k age group (4-5 year olds) in addition to our monthly theme we will focus on the letters **D**, **E**, **F** and continue to work on our year long project books. We would love all our pre-k friends to participate in our Letter Pocket activity at least once a week. We will also focus on more writing activities. By now everyone has been given at least one homework assignment. Please be sure to follow the directions given and have your child either trace their name or write their name at the top of their activity page. Remember to have them use pencils for writing and tracing, and only use crayons for coloring.

This year we will celebrate Halloween in class (October 30th & October 31st) with lots of fun activities, dancing, and stories. The children are asked to wear colors orange and/or black. They will need their lunchbox with their snack and their drink on that day. Miss Cheryl will provide a special little snack addition if they would like it.
